Dennis McClain, Regional Engineer, presented the Cast Iron Pipe Century Club Award to Melvin Doughty, Director of the City of Salem, Virginia's Water and Sewer Department, at the January 28, 2008 City Council Meeting. The qualifying cast iron pipe was 6- and 8-inch installed in 1876 from Lake Spring to East Hill.

Mr. Doughty stated what he likes best about Cast and Ductile Iron Pipe is, "strength and durability with minimum leakage and ease of construction in varying materials." He also said that iron pipe is "very dependable with minimum requirements during installation."
