

## Over 100 Years of Service . . . Town of Springhill – Nova Scotia, Canada



The Town of Springhill in Nova Scotia, Canada was recently inducted into the Cast Iron Pipe Century Club. This water utility became the 4<sup>th</sup> utility in Nova Scotia and the 29<sup>th</sup> in Canada to be so honored. The pipe that qualified Springhill was a 10-inch cast iron line installed on Herrett Road in 1904; the water line is still in service today. Shown in the picture is the Town of Springhill Mayor, Mr. Guy Brown, who received the plaque during a monthly council meeting.

Comments from the city are as follows:

We are a small utility with a significant portion of our system that is around 100 years old. We like that there is a history of long service life and that our guys can work around the pipe.
