

Over 100 Years of Service . . . Town of Parrsboro – Nova Scotia, Canada



The Town of Parrsboro, Nova Scotia, Canada was recently inducted into the Cast Iron Pipe Century Club. The presentation of the century club plaque was made at the Parrsboro city hall. The pipe line that qualified Parrsboro was commissioned in 1896 and installed in 1897. It is still functioning today only requiring minor work to maintain the line.
