

A Century of Service . . . Town of Stellarton – Nova Scotia, Canada



The Town of Stellarton was recently inducted into the Cast Iron Pipe Century Club. The water utility became the 3rd utility in Nova Scotia and the 28th utility in Canada to be honored. The qualifying pipe was a 10-inch cast iron line installed in 1893 from the reservoir into the center of town; this water line is still in service today. Shown in the picture is the Town of Stellarton Mayor, Mr. Joe Gennoe, who received the plaque during a monthly council meeting.
